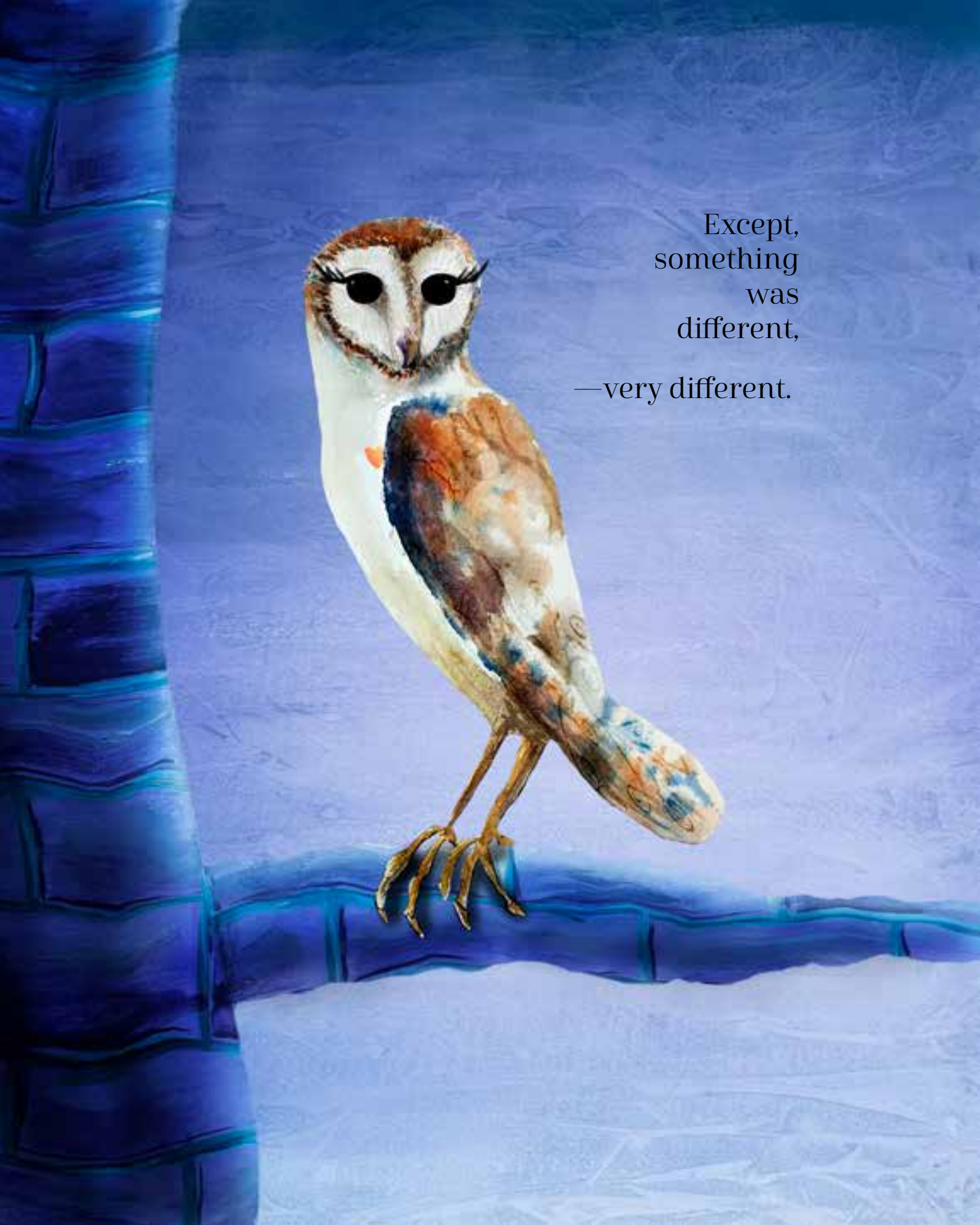
Xet couldn't get to sleep  
early one morning.



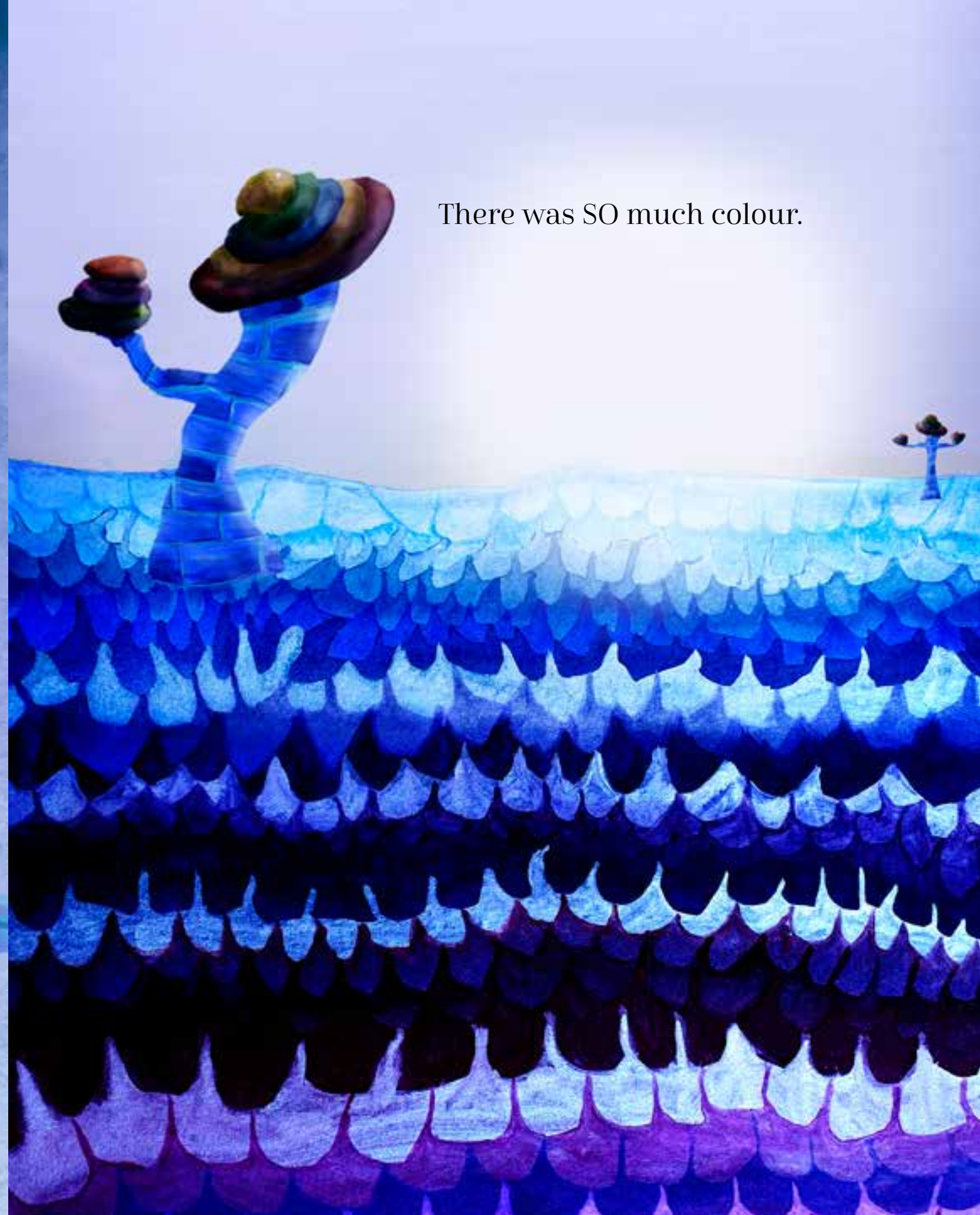
Everything *seemed* normal

*much*

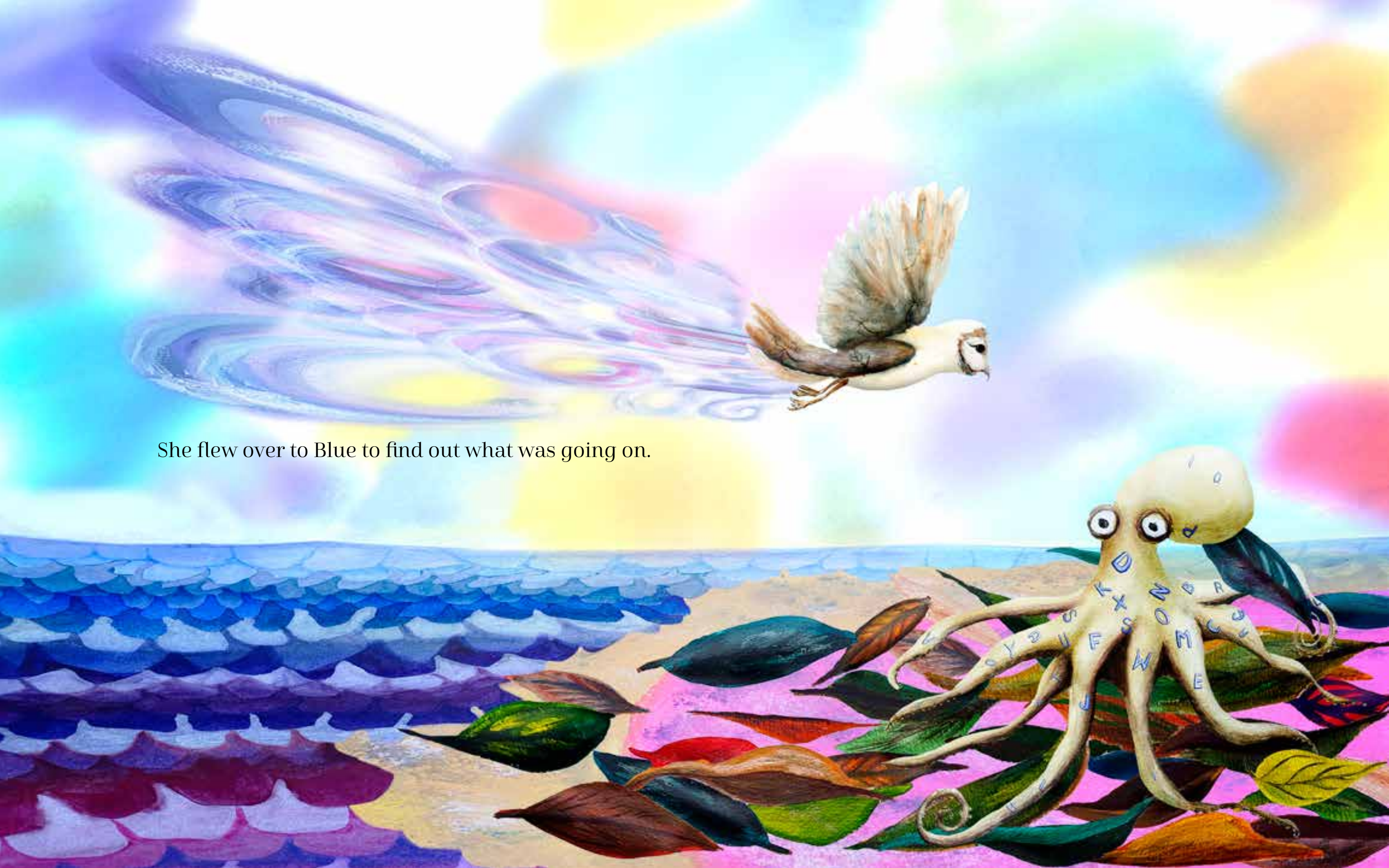

“It says Summer has lasted almost a year, the seasons didn’t change. Why hasn’t winter come?”


Xet flew around Giraffe to read all about it.

Would you like to come?”

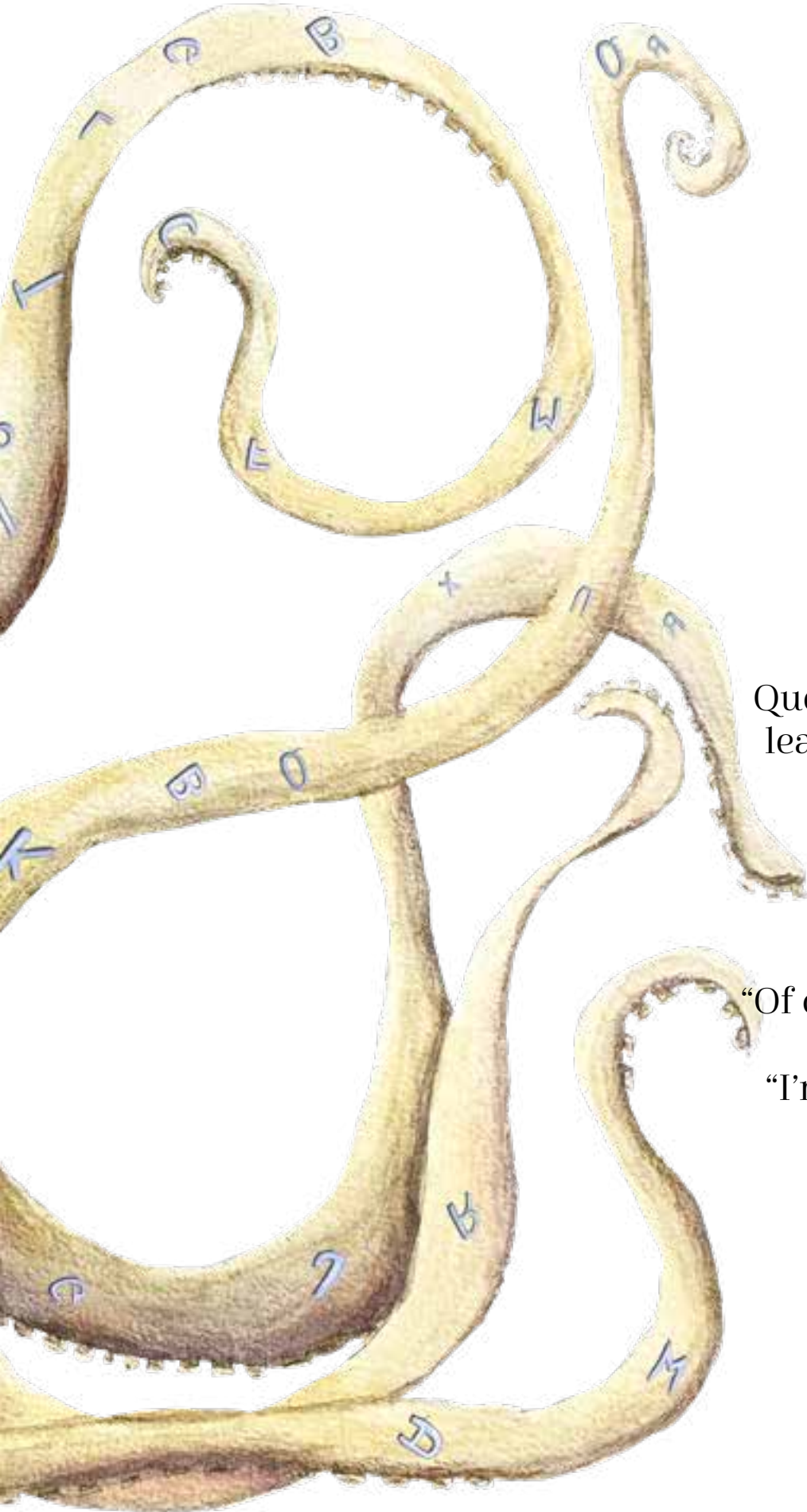


“Yes please!” Xet said.
